Please note that some microorganisms listed on your Import Permit or on your Notice are also regulated by Canadian Food Inspection Agency (CFIA). Therefore a valid Import Permit from CFIA is required for those pathogens. If you do not have a valid permit from CFIA, please contact them directly for assistance by phone at: 613-773-6520 or by [email](#). CFIA also regulates imported animal, animal product, animal by-product or other organism carrying an animal pathogen.
